Mrs. Peterson had a concern that the chrome books issued to each sophomore student could be taken home. She recommended the chrome books remain at the school. She had been to visit Mr. Brunson at the district office and he said that 5% of the students had problems with misusing their chrome books. This could translate into 15% next year when all students would be issued a chrome book. She was not certain that the punishment for misuse was appropriate. First a warning is given, then the chrome book is taken away, then the privilege to use computers at the school is taken away. She felt that there could be better filters and that some way the ads could be eliminated. She also mentioned there could be therapy for those who have a problem and need some counseling.

Carma has always been a proponent of the chrome books and shared that students could have the same problems on their phone, laptops, and computers at home.

Debbie felt if the books were issued by the school, they should be regulated by the school.

Jesse was asked to bring statistics for our school specifically to the next meeting so we have data to look at.

Ben said he knew the district was constantly discussing and updating the filtering options for home and school use. The district knows almost immediately when there is misuse of the chrome books and that the parameters are pretty diverse. The discussion will be continued after we have data to review in April.
